When do people think we should open up the country?

The Team CVoter Corona Tracker (Wave 2) survey conducted in May 2020 asked respondents about their view of the effect of the Coronavirus crisis and lockdown on their own personal savings as well as on the economy as a whole.

In today's infographic Team Polstrat breaks down when Indians think establishments such as restaurants and malls, and other educational institutions should open up.



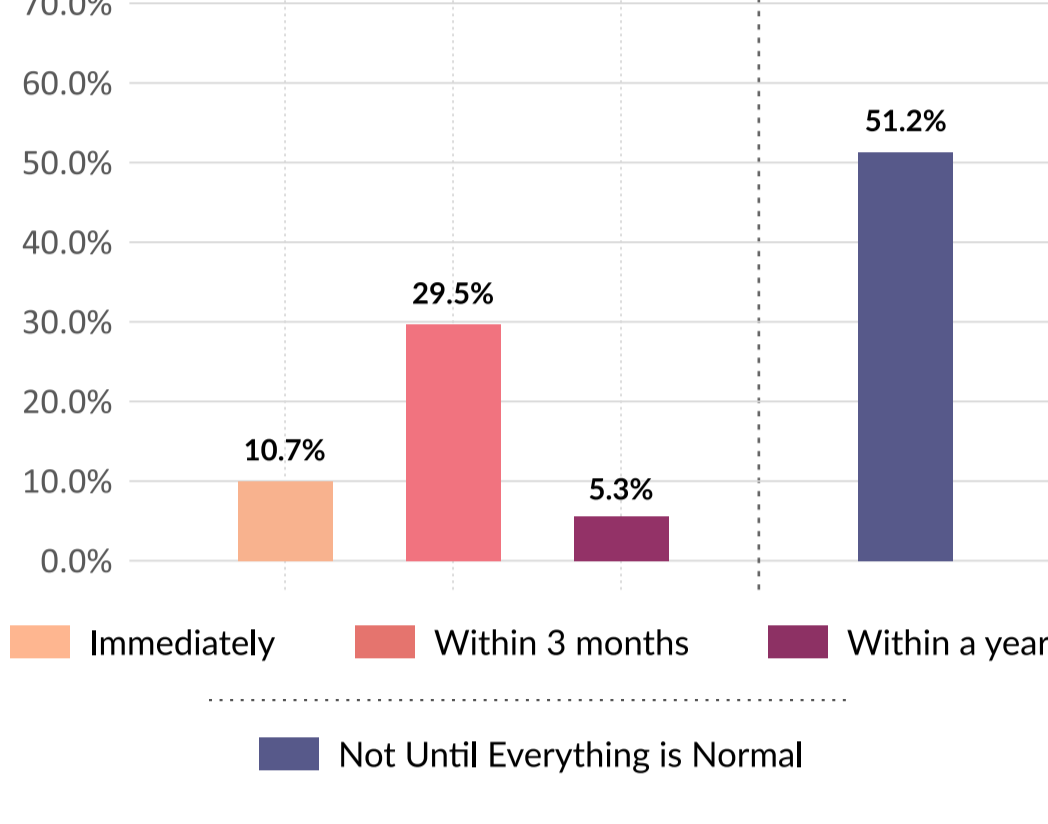
Key Findings

Overall, we observe that for all bans on schools and colleges, hotels/cinemas/malls/restaurants, international flights and large gatherings majority of respondents (50%+) think these should not be lifted until everything is normal.

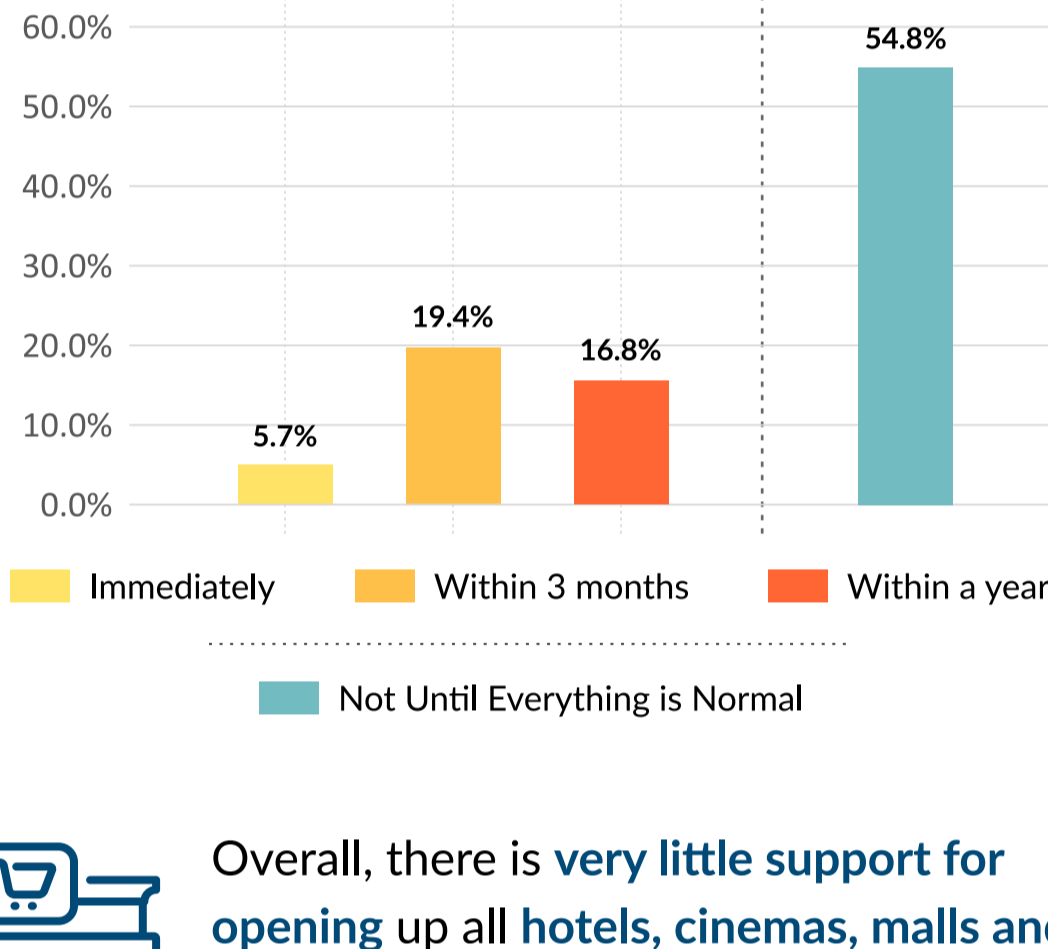


Out of all the five questions, the highest percentage of respondents (14.5%) stated they think places of worship should be opened immediately.

Q According to you when should the ban on schools and colleges be lifted?

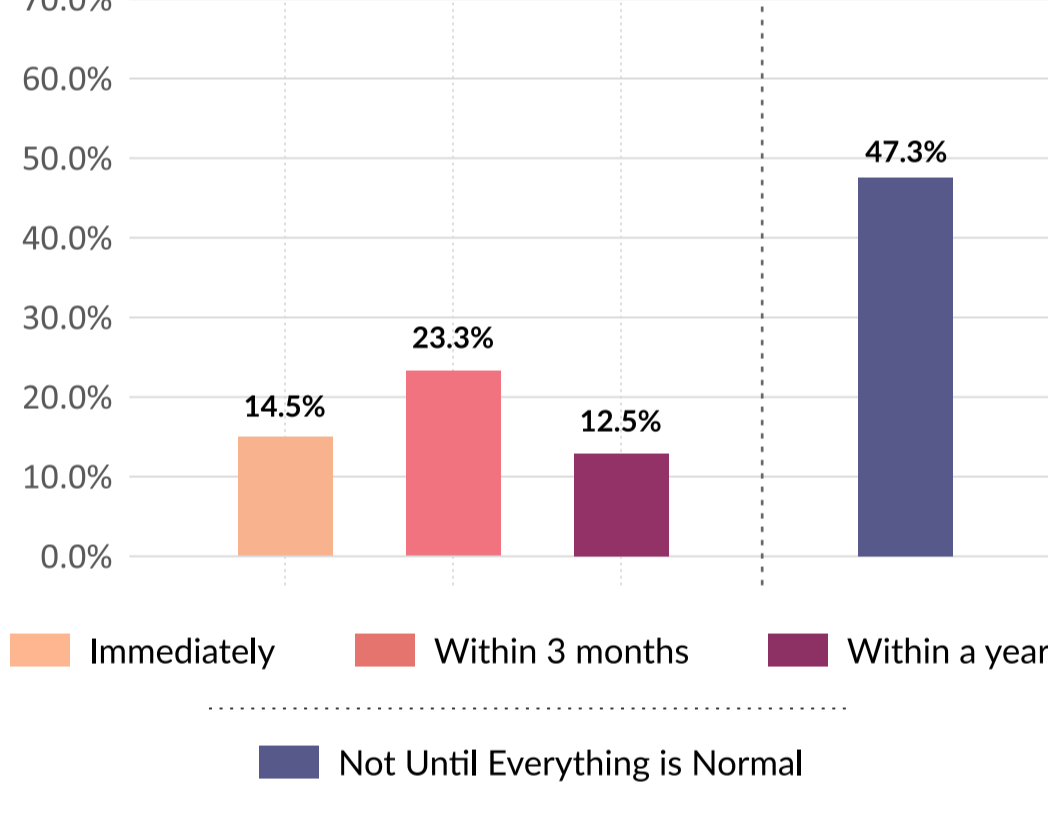


Q According to you when should the ban on hotels/cinemas/malls/restaurants be lifted?



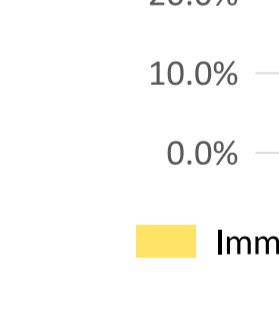
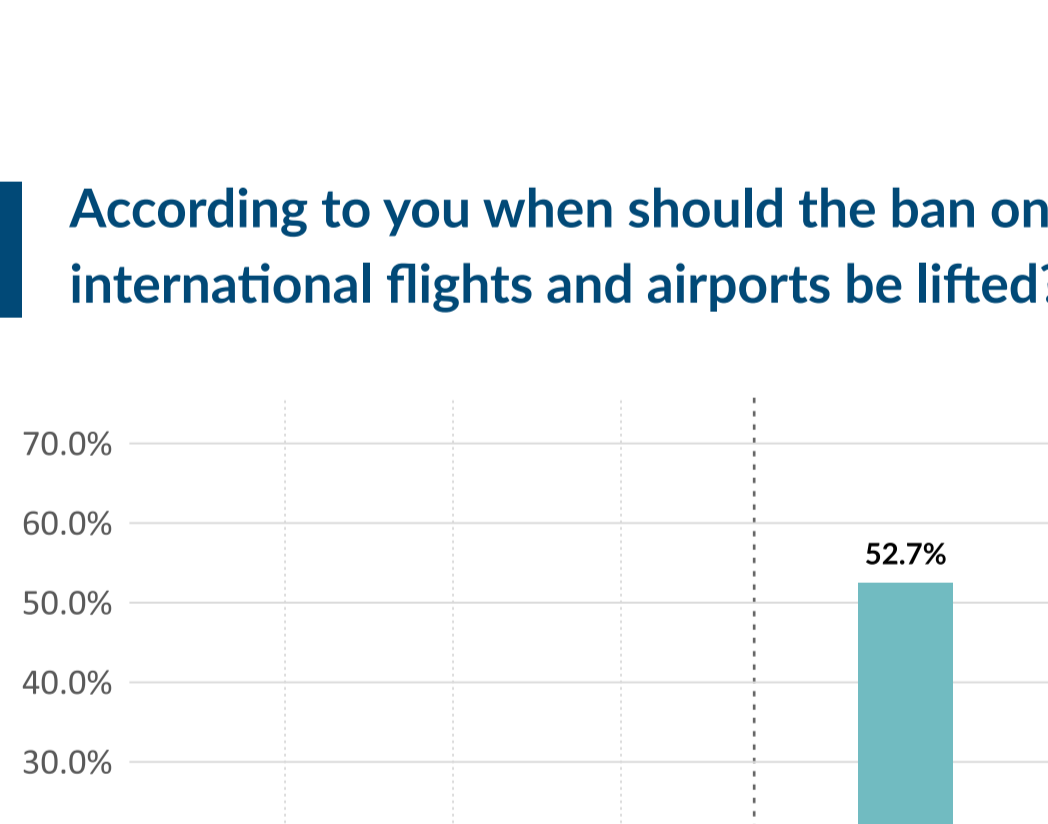
Overall, there is very little support for opening up all hotels, cinemas, malls and restaurants, with a mere 5.7% of respondents stating these should be opened immediately.

Q According to you when should the ban on places of worship be lifted?



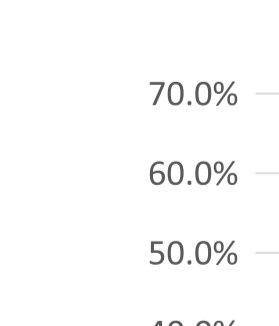
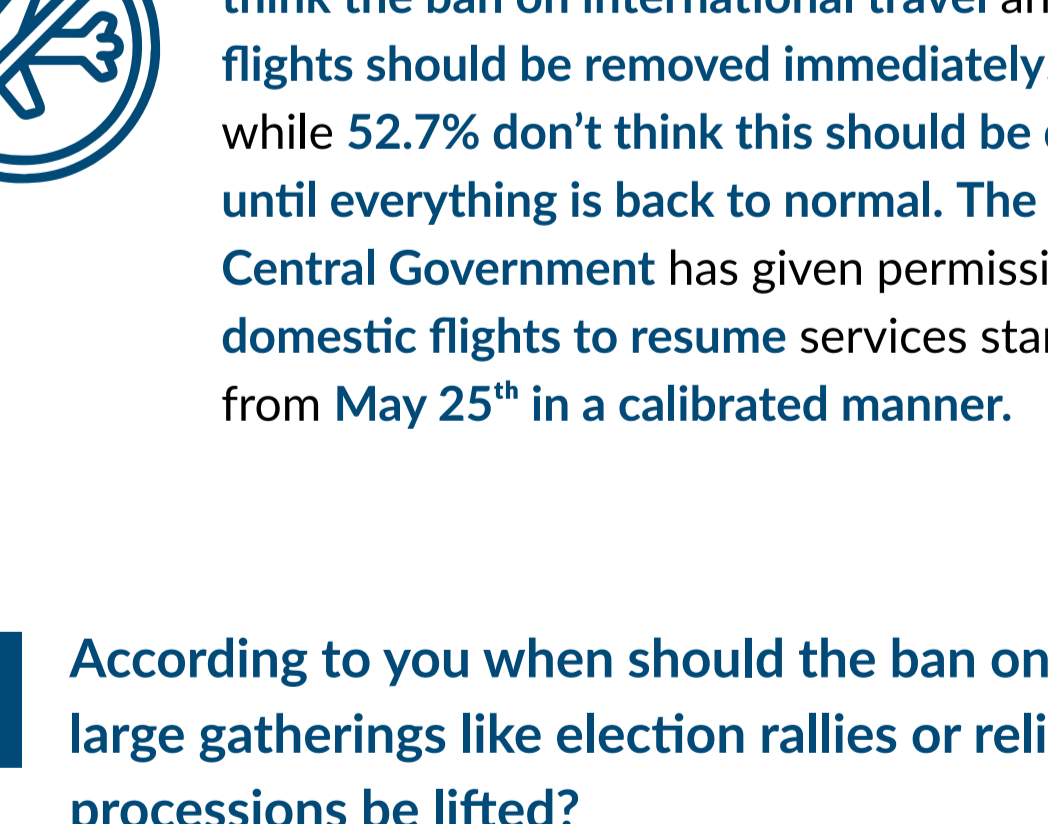
Out of all the five questions, the highest percentage of respondents (14.5%) stated they think places of worship should be opened immediately, while 23.3% stated they think it should be opened within a year. At the same time, 47.3% think these should not be opened till everything is back to normal.

Q According to you when should the ban on international flights and airports be lifted?



Interestingly, about 9.3% of respondents think the ban on international travel and flights should be removed immediately, while 52.7% don't think this should be done until everything is back to normal. The Central Government has given permission to domestic flights to resume services starting from May 25th in a calibrated manner.

Q According to you when should the ban on large gatherings like election rallies or religious processions be lifted?



Overall, there is very little support for lifting the ban on large gatherings with only 3.2% of respondents stating these should be opened immediately.

All questions had a "Don't Know/Can't Say" option that respondents could also select. This was 3.2% for Q1, 3.4% for Q2, 2.4% for Q3, 6.6% for Q4 and 4.7% for Q5. All survey findings and projections are based on the Team CVoter Corona Tracker Economic Battery Wave 2 survey carried out in May 2020 among 18+ adults statewide, including every major demographic.

The data is weighted to the known demographic profile of every state, including age group, social group, income, region, gender and education levels. (Sample Size: 1423)
